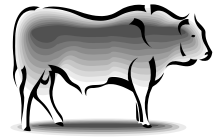

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **ALL EXHIBITORS TO FEED AND WATER THEIR OWN STOCK**
2. **Nominations close Midday, Friday 2nd June, and pens will be allocated.**
3. **All exhibits to be delivered to Hughenden Showgrounds no later than 4pm Friday 2nd June. Judging to commence 8am Saturday 3rd June.**
4. Entry fee \$7.00 for all classes, to be paid with nominations. Prize Money 1st \$40; 2nd \$20; 3rd \$10 unless otherwise stated. **Receipt of nomination fees must be presented in order to collect prize money.**
5. The committee does not undertake to care for cattle exhibited and will not be held responsible for any losses.
6. Any dispute that may arise other than Judge's decisions shall be decided by not less than three members of the Cattle Committee & in conjunction with protest regulation at the front of the book.
7. Stock shall not leave the grounds before 2pm on last day of Show.
8. All cattle to be **registered with a recognized Breed Society**. Registration certificates to be shown on pen gates, photo stat copies will suffice. Please include the following information on the entry forms:
 - Ages of cattle (in months) at time of the show.
 - PTIC status for females.
9. Heifers to mean females that have never had a calf.
10. All cattle are to be from **T.B. and Brucellosis confirmed free herds** and to be free of visible ticks.
11. Cattle will be displayed and judged in pens and therefore **need not be halter broken.**
12. All breeds will be judged together in the one section.
13. Championships will be judged from first placing's in single classes. The animal second to the champion in the class, which furnishes the champion, shall also be brought in for reserve champion awards.
14. The most successful competitor will be calculated on the following basis: First 4 points; Second 2 points; Third 1 point.
15. First, second & third placing will be awarded Cards instead of Ribbons. Competitors who wish to have a Ribbon are to present their place card to the Secretary's Office in order to collect a Ribbon.

CLASSES

ALL CLASSES EXCEPT CLASSES 801 & 811 ARE EXHIBITOR BRED.

801. Single Bull (open) 24 months & over –
802. Single Bull (exhibitor bred) 24 months & under -
803. Single Bull (exhibitor bred) 12 – 24 months –
804. Single Bull (exhibitor bred) under 12 months
805. Pen of 2 Bulls (exhibitor bred) 24 months – 36 months (only 1 entry eligible for single class entry in other classes)
806. Pen of 3 Bulls under 24 months – exhibitor bred
807. Single Heifer under 12 months – exhibitor bred
808. Pen of 3 Heifers (exhibitor bred) under 12 months
809. Single Heifer 12 - 24 months – exhibitor bred
810. Pen of 3 Heifers (exhibitor bred) 12 - 24 months (only 1 entry eligible for single class entry in other classes)
811. Single Cow (open) over 24 months
812. Pen of 2 Cows with or without calf.
813. Registered Brahman Cow & Calf (exhibitor bred)
814. Registered Cow & Calf (any breed and exhibitor bred) –

COMMERCIAL CATTLE – ALL EXHIBITOR BRED

First \$40, Second \$20, 3rd \$10 except where stated otherwise.

- 815. Pen of 3 Herd Bulls, under 36 months (any breed) only one entry eligible for single class entry in other classes. (Less than 3 entries first only)
- 816. Best Single Herd Bull, 24 - 36 months (any breed) (Less than 3 entries first only)
- 817. Best Single Herd Bull under 24 months. No older than the age brand of previous year of current show. (i.e. No 0 or No 1)
- 818. Pen of 3 Heifers, milk tooth (no calves at foot and any breed) (Less than 3 entries first only)
- 819. Best Single Heifer (milk tooth)
- 820. Breeders Group to consist of 1 Male and 2 Females or 2 Males and 1 Female. Any Breed.
- 821. Best Poddy Calf **First: \$20, Second: \$10**

LED CATTLE CLASSES – ALL EXHIBITOR BRED

- 824. Young Paraders for Competitors 21 years and under (**subject to sufficient entries**).
