RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **ALL EXHIBITORS TO FEED AND WATER THEIR OWN STOCK**
2. **All cattle to be delivered to Hughenden Showgrounds no later than 4 pm Friday 2nd June. Judging will commence 8am Saturday 3rd June.**
3. All cattle will be weighed live weight over scales at the Showgrounds.
4. **Entry fee \$7.00 in all cases to be paid with nomination.**
5. **Prize money: First \$40; Second \$20; third \$10 unless otherwise stated.**
6. All cattle must be mouthed, weighed and numbered by a D.P.I. Official or Steward. Any exhibitor wishing to mouth his cattle prior to the Show can have them done by an Official Mouther no earlier than Monday 29th May. Cattle mouthed prior to coming to the grounds must also be tagged by the Official Mouther.
7. **ALL CATTLE TO BE DE-HORNED, EXCEPT HEAVIEST BULLOCK WHICH MUST BE HORN TIPPED. ALL CATTLE MUST BE FREE OF TICK. WILD AND FRACTIOUS CATTLE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
8. The committee does not undertake to care for cattle exhibited and will not be held responsible for any losses.
9. Any dispute that may arise other than Judge's decisions shall be decided by not less than three members of the Cattle Committee & in conjunction with protest regulation at the front of the book.
10. Stock shall not leave the grounds before 2pm on the last day of the show.
11. All cattle to be judged on quality and conformation, finish and weight-for-age, and in classes of pairs, uniformity will be taken into consideration. The judge will use the following points scale: ■ 30 points for quality and conformation, ■ 40 points for weight-for-age, ■ 30 points for finish, ■ 10 points for evenness of pen (each beast in pen earns points).
12. **ALL CATTLE MUST COMPLY WITH N.V.D. & N.L.I.S. REQUIREMENTS.**
13. Transport can be arranged for Prime Cattle exhibited at Show by prior arrangements to JBS Townsville.
14. **Grass Fed Cattle only to be entered in Prime Cattle Section.**
15. The committee does not undertake to care for cattle exhibited and will not be held responsible for any losses.
16. Any dispute that may arise other than Judge's decisions shall be decided by not less than three members of the Cattle Committee & in conjunction with protest regulation at the front of the book.
17. Stock shall not leave the grounds before 2pm on last day of Show.
18. All cattle to be **registered with a recognized Breed Society**. Registration certificates to be shown on pen gates, photo stat copies will suffice. Ages of cattle are to be included on entry forms.
19. Heifers to mean females that have never had a calf.
20. All cattle are to be from **T.B. and Brucellosis confirmed free herds** and to be free of visible ticks.
21. Cattle will be displayed and judged in pens and therefore **need not be halter broken.**
22. All breeds will be judged together in the one section.

Judged on weight alone from any entry in the following classes.
702. BEST SINGLE 8-TOOTH STEER.

706. BEST SINGLE 4-TOOTH STEER.

713. BEST SINGLE MILK TOOTH STEER, 400kg & over live weight.
714. BEST SINGLE MILK TOOTH HEIFER, less than 400kg live weight.
715. BEST SINGLE MILK TOOTH HEIFER, 400kg & over live weight.
716. SINGLE PRIME COW, most suitable for manufacturing export trade.
717. EXPORT: PEN 3 FEEDLOT STEERS which are grass fed, suitable for feedlot entry for a grain fed export 100day Market. Upon entry, cattle must have 0 – 4 teeth 401 – 490kg live weight and be in store or forward condition to meet the Market specifications after 100 days on feed.
718. DOMESTIC: PEN 3 FEEDER STEERS, which are grass fed, best suited for a Domestic 70 day market. Upon entry, all cattle must have 0 – 2 teeth, 301kg – 360kg live weight and be in store or forward store condition to meet Market specification after 70 days on feed. **Perpetual Trophy sponsored by A.W. & M. L. BODE & FAMILY.**
